






# **JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR DURHAM REGION**

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?




# NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

How long are employers having to recruit for to find candidates to fill their job vacancies?










# **DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (DURHAM REGION)**

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?














# JOB TYPE Full-time vs Part-time 11% 89% PT




# **JOB POSTINGS BY SKILL TYPE**






# **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
