








JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR DURHAM REGION








DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (DURHAM REGION)

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?















DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (DURHAM REGION)













Full-time vs Part-time




JOB DURATION

Permanency of jobs posted





Job Postings by Years of Experience Required












JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD
